CCI-CIC INVESTIGATOR OF THE MONTH

Dr. Stephanie Sellers

Dr. Stephanie Sellers is a vascular biologist and new faculty member in the UBC Division of Cardiology and a New Investigator at the Centre for Heart Lung Innovation (HLI) at St. Paul's Hospital. She co-directs the Cardiovascular Translational Lab at HLI with Dr. Sathananthan and is co-leading the pre-clinical and translational science node of CCI-CIC with Dr. Laksman. She completed her Master's at the University of Northern BC and her PhD in UBC Pharmacology & Therapeutics during which she also trained at the University of Western Australia and Yale University. Stephanie completed her post-doctoral fellowship in the Dept. of Radiology at UBC supported by CIHR and the Michael Smith Foundation for Health Research. The author of >80 publications, Stephanie's research program focuses on determining cellular mechanisms driving and therapeutic targets in valvular heart disease and bioprosthetic heart valve degeneration as well as the evaluation of new imaging and interventional techniques for cardiovascular disease using in-vivo and ex-vivo models.
