We wish you an amazing holiday with family and friends!

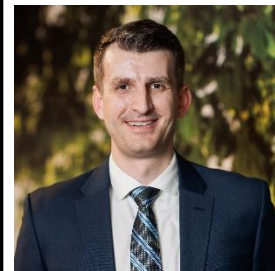

CCI-CIC INVESTIGATOR OF THE MONTH

Dr. Nathaniel Moulson

Dr. Nate Moulson completed his undergraduate degree in Kinesiology and Health Science, medical doctorate, and general cardiology fellowship at the University of British Columbia. He completed subspecialty fellowships in the Cardiovascular Performance Program at the Massachusetts General Hospital and Harvard University, and Cardiac Rehabilitation and Prevention at UBC. He completed a Clinician Investigator Program residency and is currently pursuing a Master of Health Administration. His research focus includes sports cardiology and cardiac rehabilitation and prevention. In sports cardiology, he is a steering committee member and site PI for the Outcomes Registry for Cardiac Conditions in Athletes (ORCCA) study investigating the adverse cardiovascular events and decision-making processes around return-to-sport decisions in competitive athletes with underlying cardiovascular conditions. In cardiac rehabilitation, his focus is the virtual delivery of cardiac rehabilitation and preventative services and the real-world outcomes of care delivered during the COVID-19 pandemic (VCR-COVID study). He has received funding through the BC MOH to investigate the feasibility of remote patient monitoring (Telus Health Home Monitoring) in cardiac rehabilitation and is planning to expand this work to reach rural and remote populations. He is excited for the collaborations facilitated through his involvement with CCI-CIC.

- Received Michael Smith Health Research BC Scholar Award 2022.



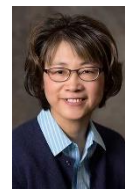
