CCI-CIC INVESTIGATOR OF THE MONTH

Dr. Christina Luong

Dr. Christina Luong is an early career investigator and Clinical Assistant Professor who joined the Division of Cardiology at the University of British Columbia (UBC) in 2019. She is the Co-director of the VGH-UBC Artificial Intelligence Echo Core Lab and reviewer for the UBC Clinical Research Ethics Board. Following medical school at the University of Alberta, she trained in Internal Medicine, Cardiology, and Echocardiography at UBC. She completed a fellowship in advanced echocardiography with a focus on stress echocardiography at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN. During her echocardiography fellowships, she also completed a Master of Health Science through the UBC School of Population and Public Health. Her research interests focus on developing and applying deep learning models to echocardiography and cardiac point-of-care ultrasound. She is a board member of the Canadian Society of Echocardiography and is active as a member of the national research pillar. Dr. Luong is a past Friedman Health Scholar and a VCHRI Mentored Clinician Scientist. She has authored 46 peer-reviewed manuscripts, many in high-impact journals, including Circulation, the Journal of the American Society of Echocardiography, IEEE Transactions on Medical Imaging, and the Canadian Journal of Cardiology.
