CCI-CIC INVESTIGATOR OF THE MONTH


Dr. Marc Deyell

Dr. Marc Deyell is a heart rhythm specialist (cardiac electrophysiologist) who joined the UBC Division of Cardiology in 2012. His early research mentorship under Dr. Bob Sheldon at the University of Calgary cemented his decision to pursue an academic career. Marc then pursued a Masters in Epidemiology after his internal medicine training. During his electrophysiology fellowship training, Marc was fascinated by patients with frequent premature ventricular complexes (PVCs). Despite the advances in treatment available for this condition, he was always struck, as an epidemiologist, by the lack of fundamental data on the natural history of patients with frequent PVCs. Shortly after joining the Division in 2012, he established a clinical and research program focused on the evaluation and treatment of patients with frequent PVCs. This led to his first CIHR grant examining the impact of PVCs in patients with ICDs. Marc was a winner of the inaugural Michael Smith Scholar award which helped protect his time to establish the PVC registry. He received a CCS Atrial Fibrillation Award that supported his research into the safety and efficacy of discharging patients on the same day as their ablation. As a third focus of his research, he is actively involved in evaluating new therapies and techniques for the treatment of ventricular tachycardia (VT). He is on the executive of the VANISH 2 randomized trial, looking at catheter ablation as first line therapy for VT in patients with prior myocardial infarction. The trial results are expected in 2024. He has also led a collaboration with BC Cancer to initiate a radiation therapy program for the non-invasive treatment of VT, supported by CAPP and VCHRI/PHCRI. This program is aiming to optimize the efficacy and safety of this new modality.


